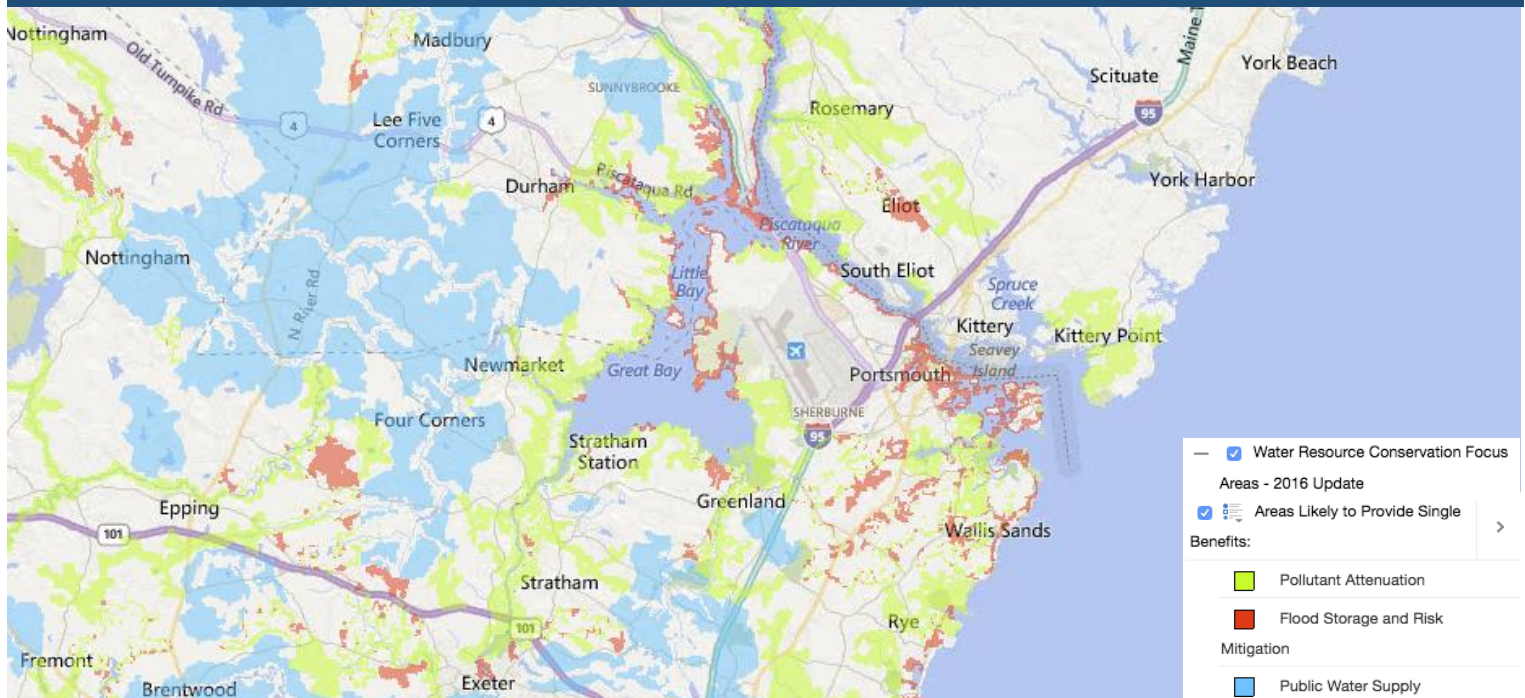

By the end of the workshop, participants will:

- Learn to save and share a project with colleagues using their own **ArcGIS online** account, and
- Practice using data layers & completing basic analyses.
